

PCYC ROUND GRENADA RACE
Notice of Race
August 19th to 21st 2016

1. ORGANIZATION

1.1 The Round Grenada Regatta is organized by the Petite Calivigny Yacht Club (PCYC). Race Headquarters will be at Le Phare Bleu Marina 19th to 21st August for the Skippers Briefing and the start of race 1 and the finish for race 2.

2. RULES

The races will be governed by the rules as defined by the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2013 to 2016 plus any changes as described in the Sailing Instructions.

2.1.1

No protests allowed. Avoid collisions at all times.

2.1.2

The course to be sailed is to the written word.

2.2

From the start at Le Phare Bleu, head out through the channel to the outer yellow mark. From there you go West around the island, to Carriacou. For race 2 (return to Grenada), we go East around the island.

2.3 SAILS

Spinnakers optional

3. CLASSES

Boats may enter to sail in the following categories: Monohull OR Multi-Hull

3.1 Skippers Briefing will be at 18h00 on Friday 19th August, at The Deck Restaurant, Le Phare Bleu Marina.

3.2 Schedule of Races and First signal

Time check 06h30 local time

Race 1:

Saturday 20th August First warning not before 06h55 Le Phare Bleu to Tyrell Bay Carriacou

Race 2:

Sunday 21st August First warning not before 09h55 Tyrell Bay Carriacou to Le Phare Bleu

4. SAFETY

Boats taking part in the race are recommended to refer to ISAF safety regulations. www.sailing.org/specialregs

4.1 For all classes anchors are permitted to stay on bow rollers and stern rollers while racing.

4.2 Boats must have suitable charts on board for the sailing area.

5. ENTRIES

5.1 Fees: \$100 EC per boat.

5.2 All boats must report for Final Registration on 19th August 2016, between 16h00 & 17h30

This is a non-handicap race. The first three boats across the line in each class will be placed.

In Carriacou we will recognize the first boat crossing the line. The final prize-giving will be on the last day of racing. The first three boats in each class will receive a prize. A prize will also be presented to the overall winner of the regatta.
