# **Notice of Race**

## 1. ORGANIZATION

1.1 The Round Grenada Regatta is organized by the Petite Calivigny Yacht Club (PCYC). Race Headquarters will be at Le Phare Bleu Marina 25-27 August for the Skippers Briefing and the start of race 1 and the finish for race 2.

#### 2. RULES

The races will be governed by the rules as defined by the World Sailing Association Rules of Sailing 2021 to 2024.

## 2.1.1

No protests allowed. Avoid collisions at all times.

## 2.1.2

The course to be sailed is to the written word as per sailing instructions

## 2.2

Race 1 will start at Le Phare Bleu. Start will be between two orange tetrahedrons as per sailing instructions.

**Race 2** will start Tyrell Bay at the Carriacou finish line for race 1. As per sailing instructions.

# **2.3 SAILS**

Spinnakers optional.

#### 2.4 ENGINES

Engines shall be turned off before the 5 minute race warning signal. If you have to use your engine during the race, please let the committee know. Using the engine will disqualify you from the race.

# 3. CLASSES

Classes will be determined the night of the skippers briefing.

# 3.1 Skippers Briefing

will be at 18:00 on Friday 25 August, at The Tropical Tavern, Le Phare Bleu Marina.

# 3.2 Schedule of Races and First signal

Time check 06h30 local time.

#### Race 1:

Saturday 26 August first warning not before 06:55. First start at 07:00. Any boat finishing after 16:00 will be given a finish time of 16:00.

#### Race 2:

Sunday 27 August, first warning not before 08:55. First start at 09:00. Any boat finishing after 16:00 will be given a finish time of 16:00.

## 4. SAFETY

Boats taking part in the race are recommended to refer to World Sailing Association safety regulations. www.sailing.org/inside-world-sailing/rules-regulations/offshore-special-regulations

- **4.1** For all classes anchors are permitted to stay on bow rollers and stern rollers while racing.
- **4.2** Boats must have suitable charts on board for the sailing area.

#### 5. ENTRIES

- **5.1 Fees:** Early registration for members \$100/EC \$150 for non-members per boat before the 20 August and an additional \$50 EC per boat thereafter.
- **5.2** All boats must report for Final Registration on 25 August by 17:30.

# 6. COMMUNICATION

Every entry must have a working VHF on board. The race committee will be operating on channel 11 for all classes. Any boat retiring shall notify the race committee by VHF if possible. When finishing, notifying the race committee of the boats name is suggested. Any boat unable to finish prior to 16:00 shall notify the race committee of position and ETA.

# 7. PRIZES

There will be a daily prize-giving after each day's racing for the first boat crossing the finish line. At the final prize-giving on the last day of racing, a prize for first overall and prizes to the first and second in each class.

## 8. COMMITTEE DESK

A Committee desk will be located at Le Phare Bleu Marina from Friday 25-27 August 2023.
